

### **Fear**

I will fear no evil; for thou (God) art with me..... *Psalm 23:4*

The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? *Psalm 27:1*

....The Lord shall give thee rest from thy sorrow, and from thy fear..... *Isaiah 14:3*

So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed for I am your God. I will strengthen

you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand. *Isaiah 41:10*

And Jesus said, "Why are ye so fearful? How is it that you have no faith?" *Mark 4:40*

### **Forgiveness**

Jesus, while hanging on the cross - being crucified by his own people - Jesus prayed:  
**"Forgive them Father for they know not what they do."** *Luke 23:34*

If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land. *2 Chronicles 7:14*

Praise the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits - who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases. *Psalms 103:2-3*

-13-

....For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more. *Jeremiah 31:34*

For if you forgive men when they sin against you, your Heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins.

*Matthew 6:14-15*

....Take heart, son; your sins are forgiven. The Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins.

*Matthew 9:2, 6*

...Forgive, and you will be forgiven. *Luke 6:37*

All the prophets testify about Him that everyone who believes in Him receives forgiveness of sins through His name. *Acts 10:43*

Therefore, my brothers, I want you to know that through Jesus the forgiveness of sins is proclaimed to you. *Acts 13:38*

-14-

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace. *Ephesians 1:7*

*NIV Note: If someone does you wrong --- it's not the person --- it's the evil spirit behind that person that is directing that person's sinful action. We are to Love the person - but - hate the Sin. Satan is the creator of evilness and his intent is to separate us from God through sin!*

### **Giving-Tithing (Sowing Seeds)**

A tenth of all you produce is the Lord's and it is holy. *Leviticus 27:30*

Be sure to set aside a tenth of all that your fields produce each year. *Deuteronomy 14:22*

Each of you must bring a gift in proportion to the way the Lord your God has blessed you. *Deuteronomy 16:17*

How can I repay the Lord for all his goodness to me? *Psalm 116:12*

-15-

Honor the Lord with your substance and with the first fruits of all your increase.

*Proverbs 3:9*

Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, "Wherein have we robbed thee?" In tithes and offerings. *Malachi 3:8*

Ye are cursed with a curse: for ye have robbed me, even this whole nation. *Malachi 3:9*

"Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse....."

test me in this," says the Lord Almighty, "And see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that you will not have room enough for it." *Malachi 3:10*

And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground..... *Malachi 3:11*

-16-

Store up treasures in heaven.....for where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

*Matthew 6:20-21*

For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? Or, what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?

*Matthew 16:2-6*

Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap.

For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you. *Luke 6:38*

Just as you grow in everything - in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in earnestness and love....see that you also grow in the grace of giving. *1 Corinthians 8:7*

Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously.

Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work. *2 Corinthians 9:6-8*

As it is written; "He has scattered abroad his gifts to the poor; his righteousness endures forever."  
*2 Corinthians 9:9*

Now He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will also supply and increase your store of seed and will enlarge the harvest of your righteousness. *2 Corinthians 9:10*

You will be made rich in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God.  
*2 Corinthians 9:11*

-18-

Not that I am looking for a gift, but I am looking for what may be credited to your account.  
*Philippians 4:17*

Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows. *Galatians 6:7*

The one who sows to please his sinful nature, from that nature will reap destruction.

The one who sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life. Let us not become weary in doing good - for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.

*Galatians 6:8-9*

And everyone who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or children or fields for my sake will receive a hundred times as much and will inherit eternal life.

Others, like seed sown on good soil, hear the word, accept it, and produce a crop - thirty,

As the rain and the snow come down from  
heaven - and do not return to it without  
watering the earth and making it bud and

flourish - so that it yields seed for the sower  
and bread for the eater - so is my word that  
goes out from my mouth. It will not return to  
me empty - but will accomplish what I desire  
and achieve the purpose for which I sent it.

For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out.....The love of money is the root of all evil.....

*1 Timothy 6:7, 10*

### **Grace**

From the fullness of His grace we have all received one blessing after another. For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. *John 1:16-17*

.....So also is the free gift.....the grace of God, and the gift by grace which is by one man, Jesus Christ..... *Romans 5:15*

-21-

....God's abundant provision of grace and the gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man, Jesus Christ. *Romans 5:17*

For the wages of sin is death. But the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Romans 6:23*

To keep me from becoming conceited because of these surpassingly great revelations, there was given me a thorn in my flesh, a messenger of Satan, to torment me.

Three times I pleaded the Lord to take it away from me. But He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness."

Therefore, I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me.

-22-

That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, insults, in hardships, persecutions, and in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong. *2 Corinthians 12:7-10*

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith --- and this is not from yourselves, it is

the gift of God --- not by works, so that no one  
can boast. *Ephesians 2:8-9*

For the grace of God that brings salvation has  
appeared to all men. *Titus 2:11*

Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through  
the knowledge of God, and of Jesus Our Lord.  
*2 Peter 1:2*

And to now know this love that surpasses  
knowledge - that you may be filled to the  
measure of all the fullness of God.

Now to him who is able to do immeasurably  
more than all we ask or imagine, according to

His power that is at work within us, to Him be  
glory in the Church and in Christ Jesus  
throughout all generations, for ever and ever.  
Amen. *Ephesians 3:19-21*

**Healing**

*Note: Some people have questioned, "Can a person be healed through the faith of other people?" The answer is yes! Read the story in Matthew 8 about the Roman Centurion who asked Jesus to heal his servant. He told Jesus, "Lord, I am not worthy that you should come under my roof --- but if you will just speak the word, my servant will be healed." Jesus marveled at his faith, and told the Centurion, "Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee." And his servant was healed in the very same hour.*

*So the lesson for each of us is: Don't ever stop praying for others - your faith works wonders.*

*-24-*

For I am the Lord who healeth thee.

*Exodus 15:26*

Lord my God, I called to you for help and you healed me.

*Psalms 30:2*

The Lord will protect him and preserve his life;  
He will bless him in the land and not surrender

him to the desire of his foes. The Lord will sustain him on his sickbed and restore him from his bed of illness. *Psalm 41:2-3*

He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions. *Psalm 107:20*

Surely He took up our infirmities and carried our sorrows..... *Isaiah 53:4*

He was pierced for our transgressions.....and with His stripes we are healed. *Isaiah 53:5*

Jesus said, "Again I say unto you, that if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing

-25-

that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in Heaven. For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them."

*Matthew 18:19-20*

A man with leprosy came to him (Jesus) and begged him on his knees, "If you are willing, you

can make me clean." Filled with compassion, Jesus reached out his hand and touched the man. Jesus said, "I am willing, be clean!" Immediately the leprosy left him and he was cured. *Mark 1:40-42*

And he (Jesus) said unto her, "Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace, and be whole of thy plague." *Mark 5:34*

When Jesus had called the Twelve together, He gave them power and authority to drive out demons and to cure diseases, and He sent them out to preach the Kingdom of God and to heal the sick. So they set out and went from village

-26-

to village, preaching the gospel and healing people everywhere. *Luke 9:1, 2 and 6*

After this the Lord appointed seventy-two (72) others and sent them out two by two to every town and place where He was about to go.

"When you enter a town and are welcomed, eat

what is set before you. Heal the sick who are there and tell them, 'The kingdom of God is near you.'" The seventy-two returned with joy and said, "Lord, even the demons submit to us in your name." *Luke 10:1, 8, 9 and 17*

The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it more abundantly. *John 10:10*

Stretch out your hand to heal and perform miraculous signs and wonders through the name of your holy servant Jesus. *Acts 4:30*

-27-

*Note: Peter and John prayed for God to move. After they prayed, the place was shaken and filled with the Holy Spirit!*

God did extraordinary miracles through Paul, so that even handkerchiefs and aprons that had touched him were taken to the sick, and their

illnesses were cured and the evil spirits left them. *Acts 19:11-12*

Publius' father was sick in bed, suffering from fever and dysentery. Paul went to see him and, after prayer, placed his hands on him and healed him. When this had happened; the rest of the sick on the island (of Malta), came and were cured. *Acts 28:8-9*

Is any among you afflicted? Let him pray. Is any merry? Let him sing psalms. Is any sick among you? Let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord.

-28-

And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

*James 5:13-15*

Confess your faults to one another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The

effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man  
availeth much. *James 5:16*

Beloved, I wish above all things that thou  
mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy  
soul prospereth. *3 John 2*

.....By whose stripes ye were healed.  
*1 Peter 2:24*

Note: This says "you were healed." The work has  
already been done. Jesus not only bore our sins on  
the cross - He bore our sicknesses as well.

### **Help**

The Lord God said, "It is not good for the man  
to be alone. I will make a helper suitable for  
him." *Genesis 2:18*

NIV Note: *Without female companionship and a partner in reproduction, the man could not fully realize his humanity (the quality of state of being human).*

In my distress I called to the Lord; I cried to my God for help. From His temple he heard my voice; my cry came before Him, into His ears.

*Psalm 18:6*

We wait in hope for our Lord; He is our help and our shield.

*Psalm 33:20*

I sought the Lord, and He answered me; He delivered me from all my fears..... This poor man called, and the Lord heard him; He saved him out of all his troubles.

*Psalm 34:4,6*

-30-

The angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear Him, and He delivers them.

*Psalm 34:7*

Turn from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it.

*Psalm 34:14*

The righteous cry out, and the Lord hears them; he delivers them from all their troubles.

*Psalm 34:17*

A righteous man may have many troubles, but the Lord delivers him from them all; He protects all his bones, not one of them will be broken.

*Psalm 34:19-20*

And the Lord shall help them, and deliver them; he shall deliver them from the wicked, and save them, because they trust in Him. *Psalm 37:40*

God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. *Psalm 46:1*

-31-

Help us, O God our Savior, for the glory of your name, deliver us and forgive our *sins* for your name's sake. *Psalm 79:9*

You who fear Him, trust in the Lord ----- He is  
your help and shield. *Psalm 115:11*

I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from  
whence cometh my help. My help cometh  
from the Lord, which made heaven and earth.  
*Psalm 121:1-2*

The Lord shall preserve thee from all evil: he  
shall preserve thy soul. He shall preserve thy  
going out and thy coming in from this time  
forth, and even for evermore. *Psalm 121:7-8*

So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be  
dismayed for I am your God. I will strengthen  
you and help you; I will uphold you with my  
righteous right hand. *Isaiah 41:10*

-32-

The spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not  
know what we ought to pray for, but the spirit

himself intercedes for us with groans that words cannot express. *Romans 8:26*

The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid.  
*Hebrews 13:6*

### **Helping A Brother In Need**

Jesus said, "I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was in prison and you came to visit me." And the righteous will ask, "Lord, when did we do these things?"

*Matthew 25:35-37*

And Jesus will say, "I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me."

*Matthew 25:40*

-33-

.....And you experts in the law, woe to you, because you load people down with burdens

they can hardly carry, and you yourselves will not lift one finger to help them. *Luke 11:46*

Keep on loving each other as brothers. Do not forget to entertain strangers, for by so doing some people have entertained angels without knowing it. *Hebrews 13:1-2*

A brother or sister might need clothes or food. If you say to that person, "God be with you! I hope you stay warm and get plenty to eat," but you do not give what that person needs, your words are worth nothing. *James 2:15-16*

If anyone has material possessions and sees his brother in need but has no pity on him, how can the love of God be in him? *1 John 3:17*

If there is a poor man among your brothers in any of the towns of the lands your God is giving

-34-

you, do not be hardhearted or tightfisted toward your brother. Rather be open-handed

and freely lend him whatever he needs.

*Deuteronomy 15:7-8*

### **Peace**

I will grant peace in the land, and you will lie down and no one will make you afraid.....

*Leviticus 26:6*

The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make His face shine upon you and be gracious to you; the Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace.

*Numbers 6:24*

Note: That was how God instructed Moses to tell Aaron and his sons to bless the Israelites.

The Lord will give strength unto his people; the Lord will bless his people with peace.

*Psalms 29:11*

Depart from evil, and do good; seek peace and pursue it.

*Psalms 34:14*

-35-

The righteous cry, and the Lord heareth, and delivereth them out of all their troubles.

*Psalm 34:17*

Rest in the Lord, and wait patiently for Him:  
Fret not..... *Psalm 37:7*

Be still, and know that I am God: I will be  
exalted among the heathens, I will be exalted  
in the earth. *Psalm 46:10*

Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto  
you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither  
let it be afraid. *John 14:27*

peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.  
*Romans 5:1*

The mind of sinful man is death, but the mind  
controlled by the spirit is life and peace.

*Romans 8:6*

I urge you, brothers, to watch out for those who cause divisions and put obstacles in your way that are contrary to the teaching you have learned. Keep away from them. *Romans 16:17*

The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet..... *Romans 16:20*

And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. *Philippians 4:7*

*Note: We cannot even begin to imagine the peace that our personal relationship with Jesus provides.*

### **Prosperity (Abundance/Wealth)**

The Lord commanded us to obey all these decrees (commandments) and to fear the Lord

our God, so that we might always prosper and be kept alive, as is the case today.

*Deuteronomy 6:24*

You might say to yourself, "I am rich because of my own power and strength." But remember the Lord your God! It is He who gives you the power to become rich.....*Deuteronomy 8:17-18*

And when you and your children return to the Lord your God and obey Him with all your heart and with all your soul according to everything I command you today, the Lord will restore your fortunes and have compassion on you.....

*Deuteronomy 30:2-3*

He will make you more prosperous and numerous than your fathers.

*Deuteronomy 30:5*

.....Then the Lord your God will make you most prosperous in all the work of your hands....

*Deuteronomy 30:9*

Who, then is the man that fears the Lord? He will instruct him in the way chosen for him. He

will spend his days in prosperity, and his descendants will inherit the land.

*Psalm 25:12-13*

But the meek shall inherit the earth; and shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace.

*Psalm 37:11*

They shall not be ashamed in the evil time; and in the days of famine they shall be satisfied.

*Psalm 37:19*

The righteous shall inherit the land, and dwell therein for ever.

*Psalm 37:29*

Wait on the Lord, and keep his way, and he shall exalt thee to inherit the land: when the wicked are cut off, thou shalt see it.

*Psalm 37:34*

"The days are coming", declares the Lord, "when the reaper will be overtaken by the plowman and the planter by the one treading the grapes. New wine will drip from the

mountains and flow from all the hills."

*Amos 9:13*

*Note: This is a picture of glorious Eden like prosperity, when the seasons will run together so that sowing and reaping are without intervals, and there will be a continuous supply of fresh produce.*

In that day the mountains will drip new wine, and the hills will flow with milk; all the ravines of Judah will run with water, a fountain will flow out of the Lord's house and will water the valley of Acacias. *Joel 3:18*

*Note: Streams of blessings will refresh His people and make their place endlessly fruitful.*

Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth. *3 John 2*

And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work. *2 Corinthians 9:8*

You will be made rich in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion.....your

generosity through us will result in thanksgiving to God. *2 Corinthians 9:11*

**Satan - How To Resist Him**

Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour. *1 Peter 5:8*

The thief (Satan) cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I (Jesus) am come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly. *John 10:10*

Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. *James 4:7*

You, dear children, are from God and have overcome them (evil spirits), because the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world. *1 John 4:4*

No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper..... *Isaiah 54:17*

I can do all things through Christ which  
strengtheneth me. *Philippians 4:13*

We know that anyone born of God does not  
continue to sin: The one (Jesus) who was born  
of God keeps him (you) safe, and the evil one  
cannot harm him. *1 John 5:18*

Note: *When you became born-again, you became  
born of God. Jesus, the son of God, keeps you safe  
from the devil, and he cannot harm you!*

....."Get behind me, Satan" Jesus said. "You  
do not have in mind the things of God, but the  
things of men." *Mark 8:33*

*Note: Jesus was rebuking Peter because of his wrong  
thinking.*

The seventy-two returned with joy and said,  
"Lord, even the demons submit to us in your  
name." *Luke 10:17*

Come near to God and He will come near to you.  
Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your  
hearts, you double-minded. *James 4:8*

Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will  
lift you up. *James 4:10*

*Note: You will always be tempted by the devil. But  
don't give in to temptation. If you resist, the devil  
will flee. But he will come again - at another time,  
and possibly in another form. Be ever alert and  
ready to resist him by speaking God's word.  
Even Jesus was tempted by the devil - but he  
resisted him by speaking God's word. Here is a story  
from Matthew 4:3-11*

After 40 days of fasting in the desert, Jesus  
was tempted by the devil: "If you are the Son  
of God, tell these stones to become bread."

*Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man shall not  
live by bread alone, but by every word that  
proceedeth out of the mouth of God.'"*

The devil then took Jesus to the Holy City and had Him stand on the highest point of the temple: "If you are the Son of God, throw yourself down. For it is written; 'He will command his angels concerning you, and they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.'"

*Jesus replied, "It is written again, 'Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God.'"*

Then, the devil took Jesus to a very high mountain (possibly one of the abrupt cliffs near Jericho). The devil showed Him all the kingdoms of the world and their splendor. The devil said, "I will give you all of this if you will bow down and worship me."

*Jesus replied, "Get thee hence, Satan! For it is written, 'Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God and him only shalt thou serve.'"* The devil left Him, and the angels came and attended to Him.

Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on  
eternal life..... *1 Timothy 6:12*

### **Wants & Desires**

The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want.  
*Psalm 23:1*

Delight thyself also in the Lord; and He shall  
give thee the desires of thine heart.

*Psalm 37:4*

That night God appeared to Solomon and said  
to him, "Ask for whatever you want me to give  
you."  
*2 Chronicles 1:7*

King David said: "Is not my house right with  
God? Has He not made with me an everlasting  
covenant, arranged and secured in every part?  
Will He not bring to fruition my salvation and  
grant me my ever desire?" *2 Samuel 23:5*

May He give you the desire\_of your heart and  
make all your plans succeed. *Psalm 20:4*

O Lord, the king rejoices in your strength.  
How great is his joy in the victories you give!  
You have granted him the desire of his heart  
and have not withheld the request of his lips.

tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has  
enough trouble of its own. *Matthew 6:34*

Come unto me, all ye that labor and are heavy  
laden, and I will give you rest. *Matthew 11:28*

Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty  
hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time:  
casting your care upon him; for he careth for  
you. *1 Peter 5:6-7*

It is vain for you to rise up early, to sit up late,  
to eat the bread of sorrows: for so he giveth  
his beloved sleep. *Psalms 127:2*

The Lord will guide you always; He will satisfy your needs in a sun-scorched land and will strengthen your frame. *Isaiah 58:11*

But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Jesus Christ. *Philippians 4:19*

### **EPILOGUE**

*People are asking, "What is going to happen? Where is this world headed?"*

*Prophets inspired by God, foretold long ago, that the political powers of this world would one day come together. And out of that, comes the leader of a one-world government.*

*Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved - even the thief, who was hung on a cross next to Jesus.*

*The thief believed that Jesus truly was the Son of God, and he simply said: "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."*

*Jesus answered: "I tell you the truth, today you will be with me in paradise."*
